LEAVE RULES

- Ordinarily a leave is not granted except in case of sudden illness or unavoidable circumstances. Application for leave must be recommended and signed by the parents/guardian. If a student is absent for more than six days without prior sanction of leave application, his/her name may be struck off the school rolls. Re-admission in such cases will entirely depend on the discretion of the Principal on fresh payment of admission fee.
- An application of leave duly signed by the parents recommended by the class teacher and sanctioned by the Principal will be considered as 'Leave'.
- Leave for mere social function is not recommended as it hampers the progress in school and minimize his interest for regular work.
- No leave is permitted during the examination, except medical cases which must be informed prior to commencement of examinations.
- It may please be noted that children will not be sent home in an emergency with any person other than the Parents/Guardian during school hours without a request from, the Parents or Guardian.
