



RULES OF SCHOOL LIBRARY

- 1. Maintain silence inside the library.
- 2. Books are our best friends. Use them with love and care. Treat them as your personal property.



- 3. Periodicals, newspapers and books are indispensable part of the library. Don't take them out of library.
- 4. Don't tear up pages or deface the book and other belongings of the library.
- 5. Don't disturb the arrangement of the books in the racks.
- 6. Don't remove the newspapers from the newspapers stand.
- 7. A 'No-Dues' certificate must be obtained from librarian if a reader (student or teacher) leaves the school.

ISSUES AND RETURN OF BOOKS

- 1. Books will be issued for fifteen days in case of teachers and for maximum seven days in case of students.
- 2. After the stipulated period, books must be returned. Failing which the person may be fined Rs. 1/- per day.
- 3. Refer books, periodicals, newspapers and magazine will not be issued.
- 4. The specimen text books can be issued to the concerned teacher for one academic session, on the completion of which they must be returned to the librarian.
- 5. In case a book is lost or defaced, the cost of the book may be recovered from the concerned reader.
- 6. Repeated reminders concerning return of books may lead to barring the reader from further issue of books. Strict action will be taken against such defaulters.
